AUCTION RULES

EXPRESS PAYMENT

The night of the auction you can avoid waiting in a checkout line by using Express Payment. Simply have your VISA or MasterCard, Discover or American Express card imprinted on a credit card form when you register. As the auction progresses, we will deliver copies of your Silent and most of your Live Auction purchase receipts to your table so you can quickly claim your purchases when you are ready to leave. Your copy of the credit card form will be mailed to you on the Monday following the auction in the envelope you address upon check-in.

BIDDING

You will be given a Bidder Number Card when you register. To bid in the Silent Auctions, simply write your bidder number on the Silent Auction bid forms. To bid in the Live Auction, hold your Bidder Number Card high with the number toward the auctioneer.

By bidding in the Live or Silent Auction, each bidder agrees to the following auction rules:

- Your bid, acknowledged by the Auctioneer, is a legal contract to purchase the item. In the Silent Auctions, the designation of your written bidder number on the Silent Auction form as the top bid is a legal contract to purchase that Silent Auction item.
- The Auctioneer reserves the right to reject any bid that is merely a fractional advance over the prior bid.
- All purchases are final and there will be no exchanges or refunds on items unless otherwise noted.

SILENT AUCTIONS

Items offered in the Silent Auctions will have Silent Auction bid forms attached to them or at a table nearby. You may bid by simply writing your bidder number on the form opposite the amount that you want to bid.

You do not have to take the next available bid amount, but may skip ahead on the form to find the amount you really want to bid. The next bidder must bid a higher amount than you did to be the successful bidder.

If you really want an item, just write your bidder number opposite the amount labeled "GUARANTEED PURCHASE." The bidding on that item is then concluded and you are the successful bidder.

You may bid on any item in any Silent Auction until that section is closed. Bidding for items in the Silent Auction sections will close at the posted times. A label indicating the successful bidder number and bid amount will be left on the item after the section is closed.

It's the flip or cynical phrase most often associated with organized crime and Chicago, but here tonight it's totally legitimate. As always, we appreciate your being at our Auction, and all your spirited bidding. But we also want to give you a chance to exercise your franchise and do what women fought for: VOTE for Legal Voice's work challenging health care providers' refusal to fill prescriptions and sell lawful medications, and just plain impose their personal beliefs on patients.

We've been in this fight for a long time – nearly 5 years officially, though the issue has been festering for at least 15 – and just when we thought we were near victory, we're being forced to start over.

After advocating hard and successfully for a rule requiring all pharmacists to dispense lawful medications on site, without discrimination or delay, we began defending the rule in federal court when anti-choice extremists sued, arguing the rule infringed on their religious freedom. Eventually we got a favorable decision from the 9th Circuit Court of Appeals, and were set to go to trial on July 26th of this year.

But the State of Washington, through the Attorney General, made a deal with the other side, and now they've started a rulemaking all over again. What's worse, the Board of Pharmacy is talking openly about making it permissible for pharmacists to refuse to dispense. Even if they refer the patient to another pharmacy (and it's not clear they will even have to make a referral), that's a huge obstacle to rural patients, people with mental illness or physical disabilities, low-income people and people without transportation options... and besides, it's just plain WRONG.

You can help us carry on and win this fight, by exercising your right to vote and donating to our pharmacy refusal work tonight. Patients – including women who need emergency contraception – will thank you. As will Legal Voice.
